Dear Educator/Parent/Guardian/Youth Provider,

The Shippensburg Community Resource Coalition (SCRC) is sponsoring an art contest for all students in kindergarten through 12th grade residing in the Shippensburg Area School District. This contest will build upon the successful Be Kind campaign held November 9th through 15th, 2025. This contest is centered around a theme of "Under the Sea: A Deep Dive into Kindness." We believe that youth who make good choices concerning friendship and community should be rewarded and recognized for their positive choices. The coalition plans to use the winning entries in a community awareness campaign to encourage other young people to dive deep into kindness and what that means to them.

Students are encouraged to think about the meaning of kindness, how they demonstrate kindness, and how others have demonstrated kindness in their life, and include this in their artwork. All types of printed artwork will be accepted (posters, photos, paintings, etc.). Entries will be judged by how clearly the student demonstrates the theme. Additional criteria are listed in the attached guidelines. Entries will be judged by SCRC Youth Advisory Council members and SCRC staff. The Youth Advisory Council consists of middle and high school aged youth from Shippensburg.

There are four age groups: Grades K-2, Grades 3-5, Grades 6-8, and Grades 9-12. In each category, there will be a First Place prize (\$100) and Second Place prize (\$25). All students who submit an entry will be recognized for their contribution. Entries are due November 15th and the winners will be announced on November 21st.

The Shippensburg Community Resource Coalition is a collaborative effort to provide quality social services and youth programs that are accessible, safe, and honor the dignity of each person. This work includes a reduction in risk factors related to youth substance use and social, emotional, and physical health in order to increase youth resiliency. Our goal is to help community members reach their full potential.

We look forward to some great examples of student artwork that show the theme of "Under the Sea: A Deep Dive into Kindness." Thank you for sharing this information with youth residing in the Shippensburg Area School District.

Please read the following guidelines carefully.

- All entries are due by 4pm on 11.15.2025 and winners will be announced on 11.21.2025
- The contest is open to Shippensburg students in kindergarten through 12th grade, including those who are home-schooled, cyber-schooled, attend parochial, private, or public school.
- Art submissions must incorporate the "Under the Sea: A Deep Dive into Kindness" theme.
- Students may submit all types of printed artwork (posters, photos, paintings, etc.).
- Art materials may not incorporate any copyrighted or trademarked characters, logos or names of specific products.
- Winners will be selected based on their use of the theme and their creativity and presentation of the submission.
- A completed entry form (including signed parent/guardian consent) MUST be attached to each submission. The consent form must include a daytime phone number or parent email address. Use the form included in this packet of information. Copy as needed. ENTRIES THAT DO NOT INCLUDE PARENT/GUARDIAN CONSENT WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.
- All submissions become the property of SCRC and will not be returned.

There are four age groups: Grades K-2, Grades 3-5, Grades 6-8, and Grades 9-12. In each age group, there will be a First-Place prize (\$100) and Second-Place price (\$25). All students that submit an entry will receive recognition.
